Code of conduct:

At Paddles we want all our swimmers to reach their full potential and enjoy the sport of swimming. In order for that to be possible we all need to follow a Code of Conduct

- Treat all swimmers, teachers and adults involved with Paddles with respect, treat them as you would like to be treated. Never discriminate against on any grounds including that of their age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, race, marital status, disability, gender reassignment, religion or sex. We are all equally important.
- Use language that isn't abusive or that may upset others. Bullying whether that be verbal or physical will not be tolerated. It could lead to you being asked to leave the Paddles.
- If you are concerned about how someone is treating you or someone else, please tell your teacher or the Welfare team. Your emails will be treated with confidentiality
- Always support the other members of Paddles
- Try to listen to your teacher during your lessons so you can hear the instructions and so can the other swimmers. Try to to set a good example to all swimmers.
- Make sure you tell a teacher if you have any difficulties at the start of the session or as soon as you become aware
- Please let a teacher know if you need to leave the pool for any reason
- Please ensure you have all medication, food, water bottles with you at the start of the lesson if necessary
- In the changing rooms respect other people's privacy and belongings. You are responsible for your own belongings
- The use of mobile phones and electronic devices is strictly prohibited unless special permission has been granted
